Sullivan Park 319 Lake Street, Chittenango, NY 13037

Open daily from 9 am until 8 pm. Rest rooms are available. Three pavilions are available by reservation from early May to early October. A Disc Golf Course is open during park hours. Sullivan Park is patrolled on a regular basis by the Chittenango Village Police, NYS Police and the Madison County Sheriff Department. There are two bocce courts and three public tennis courts open during park hours. Leagues and lessons may limit the use of the courts at certain times. Sullivan Park also has a softball field and sand volleyball court in which leagues have priority, as well as, numerous marked Healthy Heart walking trails.

Chapman Park 1463 Route 31, Bridgeport, NY 13030

Open daily from 9 am to 8 pm. Rest rooms are available. Three pavilions are available by reservation from early May to early October. The dog park includes a large fenced in area divided into two sections where small and large dogs can be free to run safely off leash under the watchful eyes of their owners. Chapman Park is patrolled by the NYS Police and Madison County Sheriff Department. Our facilities are also monitored by our Park Personnel. There are three public tennis courts open during park hours. Leagues and lessons may limit the use of the courts at certain times. Chapman Park has 2 softball fields, a sand volleyball court & 4 soccer fields. Leagues have priority. There is also a one-mile marked walking trail.

Tennis and Pickleball Courts

The Tennis and Pickleball Courts at Sullivan and Chapman Parks are now able to be reserved through our website <https://sullivan.recdesk.com>. The courts can be reserved from noon to 7:00 pm for residents and non-residents Monday—Sunday. 9:00 am to noon is open play for residents. Reservations are limited to a maximum of 2 hours on 2 courts on any given day and can be reserved up to 1 week in advance. The 3rd court will be left available for walk in resident play.

A Message from Bill Pindle, Fire Inspector

Spring 2024 Fire Safety Suggestions

Cooking grills too close to buildings—Keep a minimum of 10 feet away from buildings, and do not use grills inside a building whatsoever. Do not store LP gas tanks inside. It is best to store them outside.

When cooking outside, keep small children away from cooking grills. The cooking should only be done by adults and not by children.

Window unit air conditioners—these units overload the smaller and older circuits in your home. Be sure that your electrical wiring is capable of handling the power needed to run these units. A dedicated separate circuit is suggested.

Swimming pools—Keep your pools in safe condition. This includes the electrical and the limited access to your pool area. All small children should have adult supervision when using a swimming pool. Refrain from using lead cords on portable pools. All circuits should be GFI protected.

Keep your carbon monoxide and smoke detectors in good working order. Test both at least once a month.

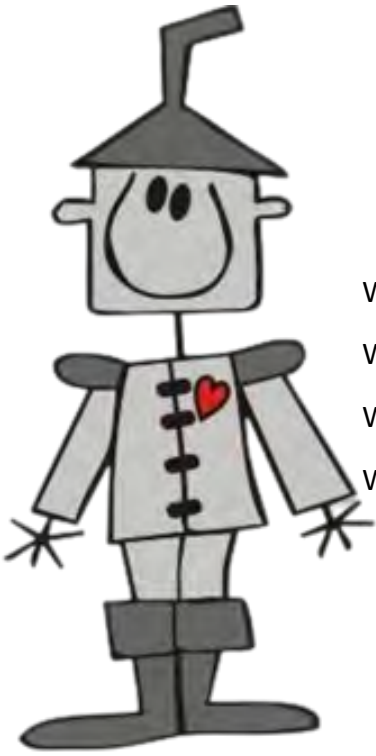
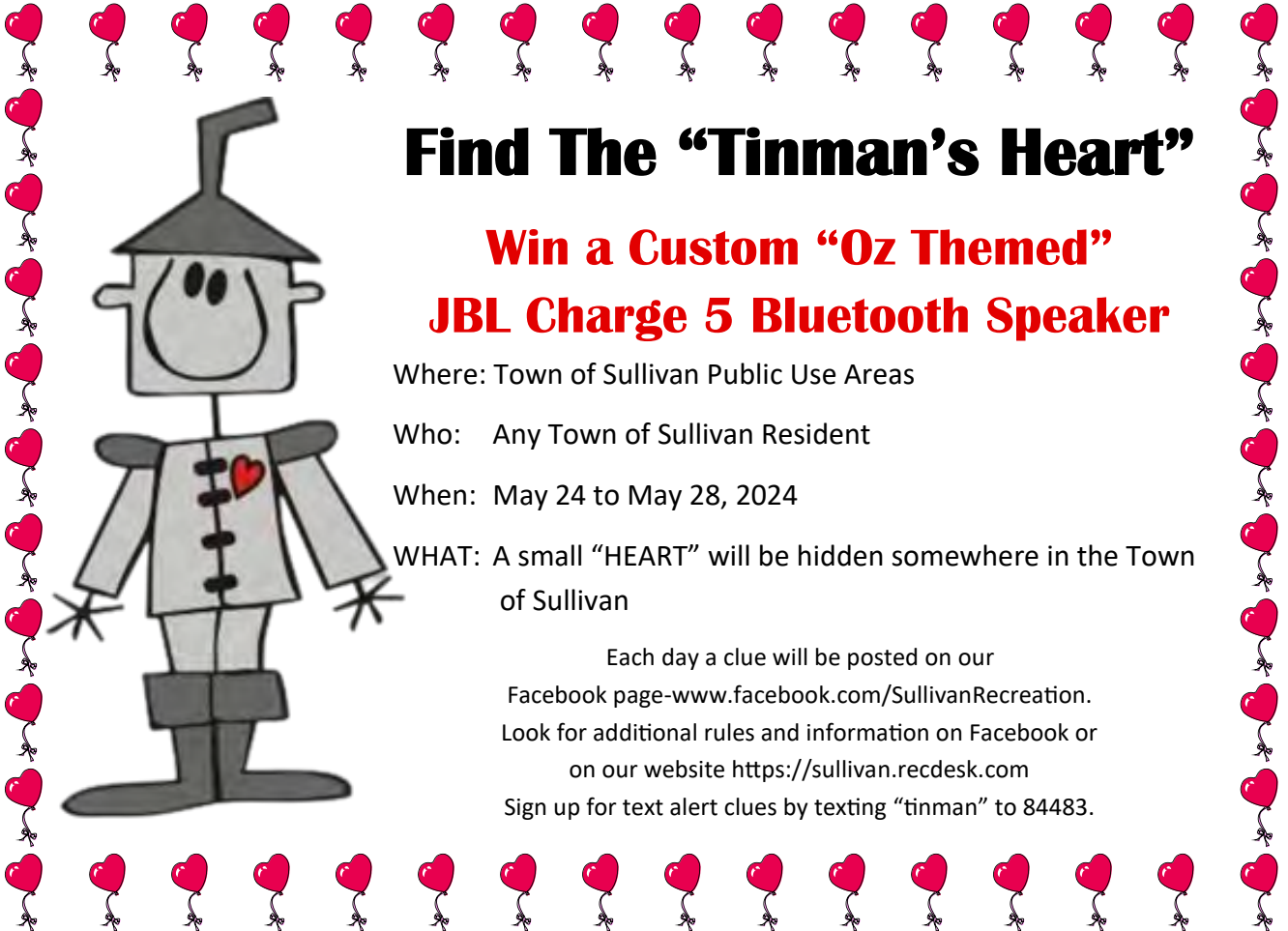
