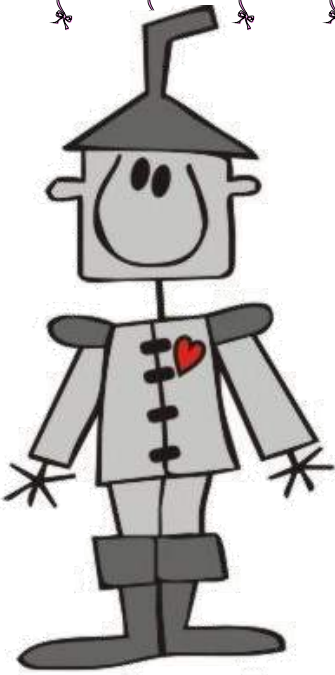

Open daily from 9 am until 8 pm. Restrooms are available. Two pavilions are available by reservation from early May to early October. A Disc Golf Course is open during park hours. Sullivan Park is patrolled on a regular basis by the Chittenango Village Police, NYS Police and the Madison County Sheriff Department. Sullivan Park also has a caretaker on duty. There are two bocce courts and three public tennis courts open during park hours. Leagues and lessons may limit the use of the courts at certain times. Sullivan Park also has a softball field and sand volleyball court in which leagues have priority, as well as, numerous marked Healthy Heart walking trails.

Chapman Park 1463 Route 31, Bridgeport, NY 13030

Open daily from 9 am to 8 pm. Restrooms are available. Three pavilions are available by reservation from early May to early October. The dog park includes a large fenced in area divided into two sections where small and large dogs can be free to run safely off leash under the watchful eyes of their owners. Chapman Park is patrolled by the NYS Police and Madison County Sheriff Department. Our facilities are also monitored by our Park Personnel. There are three public tennis courts open during park hours. Leagues and lessons may limit the use of the courts at certain times. Chapman Park has 2 softball fields, a sand volleyball court & 4 soccer fields. Leagues have priority. There is also a one-mile marked walking trail.

A Note from the Town Supervisor

Dear Residents,

Here we are, another year gone by at the blink of an eye. The 2018 year is upon us, where did the previous 17 years go? A few facts and happenings at the Town; we will be installing a new weather station with a camera at Chapman Park, it will be accessible on the Town's website. The station will be located on the Pier and be able to tell wind speed, temperature, precipitation amounts, and barometric pressure and will have a live feed camera.

The Town budget is done and we have put the tax increase at 0% again this year. We have budgeted diligently for equipment at the Highway, Fire Departments, as well as, the Park's Department without borrowing a single dime.

I'll also be giving a State of the Town Address at our first meeting in January 2018. It will be an overview of where we have been and what we expect in the near future.

Also January 3, at Madison County, if I'm fortunate to be chosen Chairman of the County Board of Supervisor's again, for another 2 year term, I will be giving the State of the County address. If chosen, I will be starting my 11th year as Chair.

On another note, I have been asked about how we communicate as a Town Board. Well the Town Board minutes are on our website, the Town Board meetings are open to the Public and videotaped and aired the following Tuesday, on Pac 99 or Public Access channel 99 on Spectrum Cable. The County Board meetings are also taped and re-broadcasted on the same channel. Also, I and a few Board Members try to put in this publication as much information as we can, four times a year. The Board would be more than glad to take suggestions on other ways to get the information out.
