Fall Fire Safety Newsletter

First, on our list, is house numbers. Please post your number on the front of your house so you can be found for fire and medical services. Time is very important in the event of an emergency. The larger the number, the better.

Second, smoke and carbon monoxide detectors should be located in each bedroom, hallways outside the bedrooms and cellar of your house. Do not install smoke detectors in the kitchen area. Carbon monoxide detectors should be located on each level of your home.

Third, wood burning stoves should be cleaned regularly at a minimum of once a year. If not comfortable, call myself or one of the fire chiefs for a free inspection.

Fourth, electrical space heaters 1500 watts are not safe to use. Try to find heaters that are 500, 750 or 1,000 watts so as not to overload your electrical wiring.

Fifth, try to pay attention to all of these fire safety suggestions. Any questions, please call one of the persons below.

Open daily from 9 am to 8 pm. Rest rooms are available. Three pavilions are available by reservation from early May to early October. The dog park includes a large fenced in area divided into two sections where small and large dogs can be free to run safely off leash under the watchful eyes of their owners. Chapman Park is patrolled by the NYS Police and Madison County Sheriff Department. Our facilities are also monitored by our Park Personnel. There are three public tennis courts open during park hours. Leagues and lessons may limit the use of the courts at certain times. Chapman Park has 2 softball fields, a sand volleyball court & 4 soccer fields. Leagues have priority. There is also a one-mile marked walking trail.

Sullivan Park 319 Lake Street, Chittenango, NY 13037

Open daily from 9 am until 8 pm. Rest rooms are available. Three pavilions are available by reservation from early May to early October. A Disc Golf Course is open during park hours. Sullivan Park is patrolled on a regular basis by the Chittenango Village Police, NYS Police and the Madison County Sheriff Department. There are two bocce courts and three public tennis courts open during park hours. Leagues and lessons may limit the use of the courts at certain times. Sullivan Park also has a softball field and sand volleyball court in which leagues have priority, as well as, numerous marked Healthy Heart walking trails.

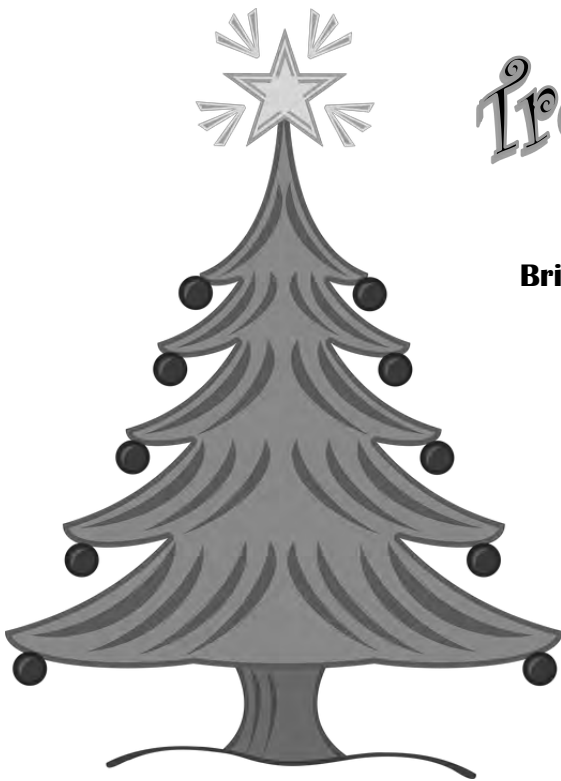

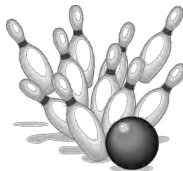

Steps to participate in the lottery

- Fill out a pavilion reservation form located in the forms section of the website at <https://sullivan.recdesk.com> or stop and pick up a form at the office.
- All RESIDENT reservations must include a \$50.00 non-refundable reservation fee at the time their form is submitted.
- Forms and payment can either be dropped off in the drop box at the main entrance of the Parks & Recreation Dept. building or sent by mail to the Town of Sullivan Parks & Recreation Dept. 707 Legion Drive, Chittenango, NY 13037.
- The fee can be paid by check (payable to Sullivan Community Council) or credit card. Please include an alternate pavilion or date when turning in your forms. In the event the pavilion requested is not available, your payment will be returned to you.
- *To be included in the RESIDENT lottery, forms must be in handed in by noon on Monday, March 16, 2026.* The office staff at the Parks & Rec. Dept. will then do a random drawing and input these reservations in the system before opening up online reservations on March 18.
- For residents preferring to make reservations on our website, online reservations will be accepted starting Wednesday, March 18.
