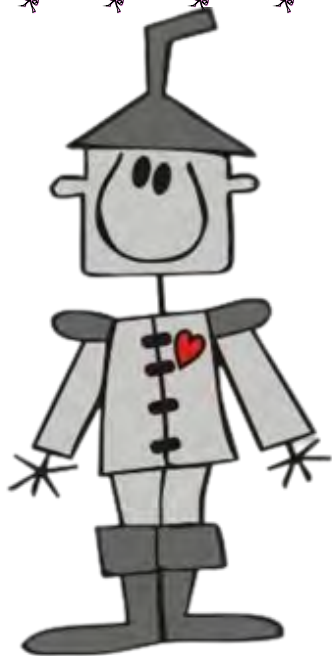

Open daily from 9 am until 8 pm. Rest rooms are available seasonally. Three pavilions are available by reservation from early May to early October. A Disc Golf Course is open during park hours. Sullivan Park is patrolled on a regular basis by the Chittenango Village Police, NYS Police and the Madison County Sheriff Department. There are two bocce courts and three public tennis courts open during park hours. Leagues and lessons may limit the use of the courts at certain times. Sullivan Park also has a softball field and sand volleyball court in which leagues have priority, as well as, numerous marked Healthy Heart walking trails.

Chapman Park 1463 Route 31, Bridgeport, NY 13030

Open daily from 9 am to 8 pm. Rest rooms are available seasonally. Three pavilions are available by reservation from early May to early October. The dog park includes a large fenced in area divided into two sections where small and large dogs can be free to run safely off leash under the watchful eyes of their owners. Chapman Park is patrolled by the NYS Police and Madison County Sheriff Department. Our facilities are also monitored by our Park Personnel. There are three public tennis courts open during park hours. Leagues and lessons may limit the use of the courts at certain times. Chapman Park has 2 softball fields, a sand volleyball court & 4 soccer fields. Leagues have priority. There is also a one-mile marked walking trail.

Tennis and Pickleball Courts

The Tennis and Pickleball Courts at Sullivan and Chapman Parks are now able to be reserved through our website <https://sullivan.recdesk.com>. The courts can be reserved from noon to 7:00 pm for residents and non-residents Monday—Sunday. 9:00 am to noon is open play for residents. Reservations are limited to a maximum of 2 hours on 2 courts on any given day and can be reserved up to 1 week in advance. The 3rd court will be left available for walk in resident play.

Sullivan Park Disc Golf Course

Did you know that Sullivan Park is home of one of the highest rated public disc golf courses in New York State? Currently it features 27 holes with 9 additional holes added this spring. The course features concrete tee pads, multiple basket layouts, elevation changes and shot variety that newcomers and seasoned players are sure to enjoy. Use of the course is free and open from 9 am to dusk year-round.

A Message from Bill Pindle, Fire Inspector

Life safety message from Bill Pindle, Town of Sullivan Fire Inspector

Every household must have fire and carbon monoxide detectors. A carbon monoxide detector should be on each level of your home. A smoke detector should be placed in each bedroom and one in all living areas of your home. Smoke detectors are not recommended in the kitchen. All basements should have a smoke detector and carbon monoxide detector.

Electric space heaters that are 1500 watt are not safe to use on electrical wiring. 500-watt, 750 watt and 1,000-watt heaters are much safer to use. If the outlet gets hot, refrain from using any electric heater.

Wood burning fireplaces need to be cleaned regularly. Pay attention to all clearances. If in doubt, call for a free fire inspection.

House numbers are very important so we can find you, especially for medical emergency calls when seconds count. PLEASE post your house number on the front of your house, using 5 to 6 inch size numbers. This is very helpful in identifying houses.

Have an emergency plan in place where everyone in the house can meet in the event of a house fire. For example, the front of the house or at either side of the house so the fire chief can find you.

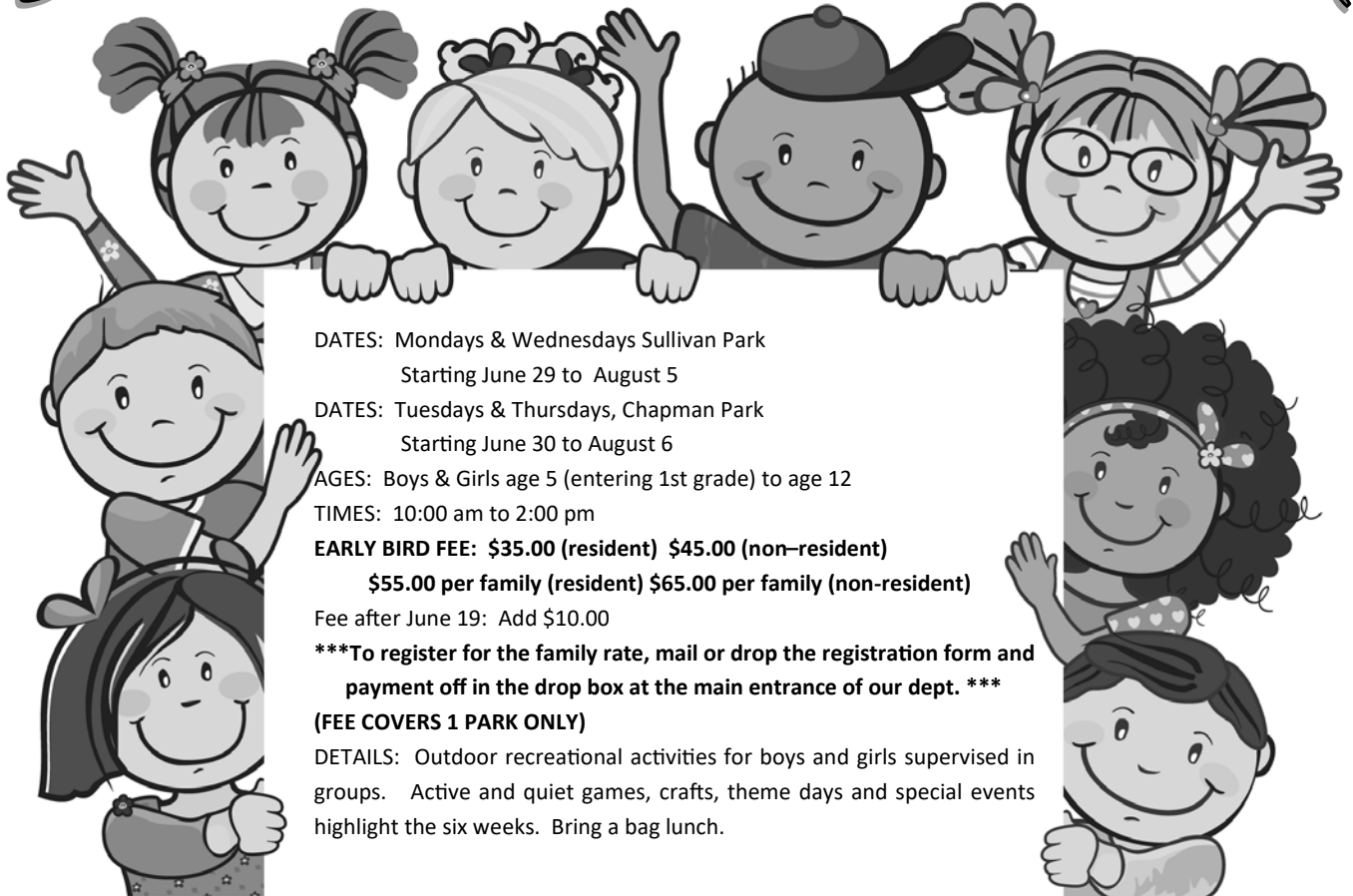

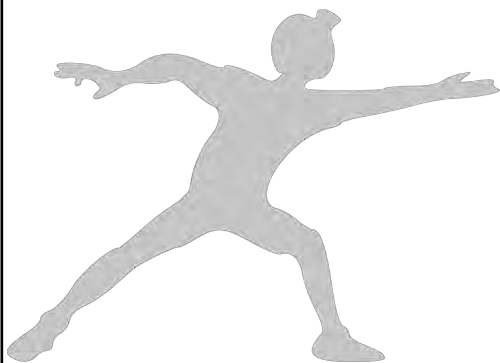

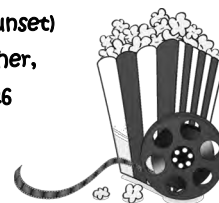
